On behalf of the ConocoPhillips Company (GOM Co. No. 00056) and its affiliate Burlington Resources Offshore Inc. (GOM Co. No. 01904), and with the concurrence as indicated below by: (a) Michael Warner, the duly appointed Chapter 7 Trustee of Cox Oil Offshore, L.L.C. (GOM Co. No. 03152) and (b) Poston Minerals, LLC (GOM Co. No. 03599) effective, July 11, 2024 the undersigned record title working interest owners relinquish OCS Lease G-02893 ("Lease") pursuant to 30 C.F.R §556.1101. Furthermore, the undersigned designate ConocoPhillips Company as agent for decommissioning of the Lease.

Please be advised that with respect to this lease relinquishment request or any other matters, we have been unable to contact and obtain consent of Pemeta Oil Company (GOM Co. No. 02301, herein "Pemeta"), which owns approximately one percent (1.22573%) record title working interest in the Lease. Pemeta lost its status in Delaware, its state of incorporation, in 1998 for failure to pay taxes (see attached Exhibit "A") and in Texas in 2000 for the same reason (see attached Exhibit "B"). Pemeta has no active qualified representative on file and appears to have ceased operating over twenty (20) years ago. We have discussed the Pemeta situation with your solicitor's office and believe there to be precedent for accepting the relinquishment of the Lease without express authorization by Pemeta.
