Dear Mr. Parkman:

By letter dated June 24, 2024, EC Offshore Properties, Inc. (ECOP) requests a Suspension of Production (SOP) and a revised activity schedule for Lease OCS 0184 (the Lease), East Cameron (EC) Block 72. The Lease is held by prior operations through August 2, 2024.

In June 2023, ECOP successfully performed recompletion operations in Well C007 on the Lease. ECOP subsequently performed additional operations in Well C007, including zonal testing. Upon the completion of offshore and onshore facilities installations, ECOP expects to restore production from the Lease by the end of November 2024.

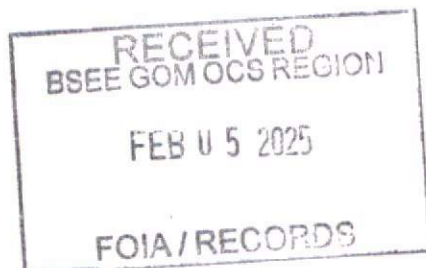
